***How to read this kit.** Everything below is sorted into three honest buckets — **TRUE, HONEST, and META** — and the sort is explained in its own section. We would rather show you the seams than hide them. Every external claim carries a visible, human-readable link, a date, and where possible a DOI, so you can check it yourself. Nothing here is taken on faith, and neither should you take it.*

1. The announcement, in brief

On **9 July 2026**, EducateWright — a pre-formation nonprofit initiative formed by SolutionWright and Universal Natural Intelligence — announced its public launch alongside a **\$25 million funding commitment pledged by its founding partners**: \$20 million earmarked for educational grants and Workshop scholarships, and \$5 million earmarked for fully-subsidized workforce mentorships.

The word *pledged* is exact. This is a funding commitment offered outward by the founding partners — not a formed nonprofit sitting on cash. Formal formation, governance, and entity status will be confirmed after factual and legal review.

Its work is plain: **anti-violence outreach, education, and the long work of teaching people to teach again**. Its belief is plainer: *software does not end violence, and code does not teach a child. People do*. EducateWright exists to fund those people, and to grow the next ones.

2. Three doorways in

A different entrance for every kind of hand. All three are open now.

3. UNI & Active Inference — a plain-language 101

What UNI is. Universal Natural Intelligence (UNI) is an *architecture and framing* for building agents from **standard active inference** and the **Free Energy Principle** — the established science associated with Karl Friston and colleagues. UNI is the engineering discipline around that established loop: how the model, the priors, and the policies are structured, tested, and kept honest. It is **not** an LLM wrapper, and **not** LLM tooling.

Active inference, in five steps. An agent does not answer a prompt; it runs a loop that turns perception into action and back again:

1. **Perceive** — take in observations: what actually happened, not what it hoped would happen.
2. **Infer** — update beliefs to reduce *variational free energy*, the gap between what the internal model predicted and what was just sensed.
3. **Evaluate** — score the available policies by *expected free energy*, weighing progress toward the goal against reducing what is still uncertain.
4. **Act** — commit to the policy expected to reduce surprise, and take that action, which produces the next observation.
5. **Learn** — revise the generative model and its priors from the outcome, so the next pass is better calibrated than the last.

Where the idea comes from. This is not new science. The lineage runs from Ibn al-Haytham's *Book of Optics* (c. 1040) and Helmholtz's "unconscious inference" (1867), through Craik's internal models (1943), Cox and Jaynes on probability as the logic of belief, Rao & Ballard's predictive coding (1999), the Bayesian-brain program (Knill & Pouget, 2004), to Friston's free-energy principle (2010) and the 2022 MIT Press textbook by Parr, Pezzulo & Friston. What UNI is careful *not* to claim. Not a new scientific field. Not a new free-energy formalism. Not achieved general intelligence, consciousness, or biological equivalence. It is a working hypothesis on a path toward *General Natural Intelligence* — evidence-classed, fenced, and tested in the open.

4. Grow Bigger Worlds — a book, and an invitation

EducateWright's story rests on a children's book by Michael Polzin, "**Big Brains Need Big Worlds**" (subtitle: *A story for children who carry whole skies inside them*), available today in English, Hindi, and Spanish at <https://universalnaturalintelligence.com/book>.

The premise. Some children carry weather inside — a whole sky, a drum, a sea of words — and are handed "*a small school with rules that fit like shoes a size too tight.*" They meet a **Regenerative Architect** who is *making more world*: "I help worlds grow big enough for the people already in them." The book's moral is the whole thesis of EducateWright in one line:

"We notice when a child is shaped wrong for their cage — and we change the cage. Not the child."

And its closing address to the reader:

"You are not too much. Your inside is not broken. Wide insides deserve wide outsides. The world is being built right now by people who know this. You can be one of them. Come on. Bring your sky. Bring your drum. Bring your sea. Let's go make more world."

The invitation: sponsor a child's expression (DRAFT program)

This is a draft invitation, consistent with EducateWright's pre-formation status. Details, safeguards, and terms will be confirmed as the initiative forms; nothing here is a finished offer.

We are inviting **artists** — of any medium — to **sponsor a child**: to teach that child a form of expression, and to help what the child's natural curiosity produces become *shareable*. The child creates; the artist mentors and co-signs; EducateWright helps carry the cost and keep it safe. The contribution can be **an illustration, a song, a poem, a sculpture, a digital work or NFT, or any expression at all** — whatever the child's curiosity, given room, chooses to make.

- **What the artist gives:** time, a craft, and mentorship — a doorway, not a curriculum.
- **What the child keeps:** the work, the skill, and the dignity of having made something the world can see.
- **What EducateWright does:** fund the seat, safeguard the child, and gather the works into a shared, growing library of natural curiosity — *more world, made by the people already in it.*

Read the title literally: this is an **organic-operator and AI-operator collaborative review**. The Zenodo record lists Michael Polzin as first author alongside AI systems (Anthropic's Claude and two OpenAI Custom GPTs) — **not human co-authors** — and it is a **preprint (v0.1.0), not a peer-reviewed result**. We state this plainly rather than let "et al." imply a faculty of humans.

Reproducibility (as reported in the release). A deterministic suite of 87 pytest assertions across 11 numerical demonstrations, reported verified on Linux, Windows, and macOS. Layer 1 (machine-executable checks) reported complete; Layer 2 (human expert review) open and pending.

7. True / Honest / Meta — the claims ledger
